{This would include areas of study such as Drafting (DFT), Intelligence Operations Studies (IOS), Law Enforcement Operations (LEO), Welding (WLD), etc.}

Through TROY's Bachelor of Science in Occupational Education, technical credits from this institution that are normally not transferable to TROY, may be applied to 30sh of this particular bachelors degree. The BSOE combines theory with experience to prepare students as workforce development professionals in a variety of settings and occupations. Please contact TROY's College of Education/Department of Leadership Development and Professional Studies for more information.

Other areas of study where such vocational/technical credit may be applied would be the Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies and the Bachelor of Applied Science in Resources and Technology Management.

Any technical/vocational area of study in which a minimum of 18 semester hours has successfully been completed may also be considered for a Specialization in the TROY Bachelor of Applied Science degree or a Contract Minor option within the TROY Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies program.
