Therefore, please understand that these listings are a culmination of TROY courses and transfer courses as of this current date. As requirements and course descriptions may change, this transferability information is subject to change at any time, without prior notification.

Students eligible for Service members Opportunity Colleges (SOC) programs or other articulation agreements may not always see those courses as listed on those specific agreements.
