

**The Bachelors of Science in Nursing offers early acceptance for high school seniors and Troy University students who are currently freshmen. Requirements for early acceptance have been approved by the Undergraduate Academic Council:**

Troy University BSN program offers two opportunities for early acceptance into the clinical sequence of the curriculum. The BSN Early Acceptance Program is an option for both High School Seniors and for Troy University students who are completing their Freshman year at Troy.

**Requirements for High School Seniors**

High School

1. A minimum high school GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale
2. An ACT score of 25 composite or SAT of 1200
3. Completion of
  - a. 1 year of Biology
  - b. 1 year of Chemistry or Physics
  - c. Algebra I, Algebra II and Geometry
4. Must place in MTH 1112 and ENG 1101
5. Apply for admission to Troy University
6. Apply for admission to the Troy University Early Acceptance BSN Program

Students must maintain the following requirements while completing academic courses at Troy University:

1. Must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.2 and a minimum grade of a C on all coursework
2. Must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester, excluding summer
3. Must complete all academic courses in a maximum of 5 semesters
4. Student are encouraged to complete all academic courses at Troy University
5. The semester prior to the completion of academic pre-requisites, complete the Early Acceptance BSN program documents

**Requirements for Troy University Freshmen**

Troy University School of Nursing offers an Early Acceptance Program for qualified students who have successfully completed their Freshmen year of pre-nursing, pre-requisite courses at Troy and have achieved an overall GPA of 3.2 or above. These students are guaranteed admission to the BSN clinical sequence (Junior and Senior year) when the following requirements are met.

Academic Requirements

1. Must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.2 and a minimum grade of a C on all coursework
2. Apply for admission to the Troy University Early Acceptance BSN Program

3. Have completed their Freshman year of college including the following courses: MTH 1112 and CHM 1142/CHM L142
4. Must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester, excluding Summer
5. Students are encouraged to complete all academic pre-requisites at Troy University
6. The semester prior to the completion of academic pre-requisites, complete the Early Acceptance BSN program documents
